From here it's time to head underground, with an opal mine tour at Coober Pedy. From Coober Pedy, we travel to William Creek, on the Oodnadatta Track.

Further down the Oodnadatta track, we stop off at Kati Thanda – Lake Eyre, then onto lunch at the Marree Hotel, before setting up camp at Farina.

From Farina, our next stop is Peterborough. The Railway Museum here is a must see. Leaving Peterborough, it's time to head back to Adelaide.
